

HOW TO PRINT YOUR FREE ARTWORK

Printing the PDF At Home

This free collection is available as a PDF for printing convenience.

Open the PDF

Use any PDF reader (like Adobe Acrobat or your browser's built-in PDF viewer) to open the file.

Choose Your Print Size

Decide what size you'd like to print your wall art. Common options include:

- 8"x10" for a standard frame
- 11"x14" for a larger statement piece
- A custom size for a unique look that fits your space

Set Up Your Printer

- Make sure your printer is connected and has enough ink.
- Select the "Print" option from your PDF viewer.

Adjust Print Settings

- Under the "Page Scaling" or "Size Options" section of the print dialog, choose "Actual Size" to maintain the original dimensions of the artwork.
- If you want to print at a different size, select the desired dimensions (for example, 8"x10") in your print settings and ensure the artwork is centered on the page.

Check Print Preview

Review the print preview to make sure everything looks aligned and centered.

Print Your Artwork

Click "Print" and your wall art will be ready to frame and display!

If you're printing at home, use your **printer's highest quality print settings** (usually found in the "Print Setup" or "Advanced" settings).

- Be sure to select the correct paper type (such as glossy or matte) to get the best results.
- For the sharpest colors, use a **color printer** and check your ink levels before printing.

Paper Size and Quality

For the best quality, we recommend printing your wall art on **high-quality paper** like **matte or satin photo paper**, which will give your art a professional finish.

- **Standard Size:** Most of our prints are designed to fit standard frame sizes like 8" x 10" or 11" x 14", but always check the size of the file to confirm.

Printing at a Local Print Shop

If you prefer professional-quality prints, you can take your file to a **local print shop** or use an **online print service**. Simply save the file to a USB drive or email it to the shop in the file format provided.

- Popular print shops like **FedEx Office**, **Staples**, or **Shutterfly** offer various paper choices and finishes.

Framing Your Art

Once your print is ready, it's time to frame it! Here are a few tips for framing:

- Choose a frame that complements your décor and matches the size of your print.
- If you can, use **matting** to create a more polished look and make the art pop.
- If you're framing the art yourself, make sure it's centered and securely mounted in the frame for a neat finish.
